Sons of Fake Left are making their presence felt whenever they are given reasonable stud chances.

With a bankroll of \$796,567, Robin Hood, who is Fake Left's richest entire son and his third richest progeny overall, has stud credentials second to none. Only Blacks A Fake (\$3,084,431), who is bred on an identical cross, and B Good Johnny (\$1,480,984) are ahead of him on Fake Left's list of stakemoney earners.

Robin Hood is to enter stud duty at one of New South Wales leading studs – Yirribee Pacing Stud, Wagga – where River Khan, Brioso Hanover and John Street North head a select sire list.

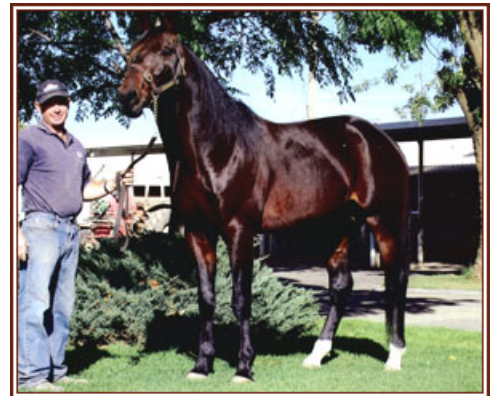
Robin Hood, who had a record of 1:55.8, won 24 races including seven at Group level. His brilliant speed and courage have marked him as a champion performer.

He won over all distances from 1609 to 3150 metres and won feature races in four States including the Victoria Cup, Treuer Memorial, Kilmore Cup, Ballarat Cup, Cranbourne Cup, NSW Cordina Sprint, Melton Plate, Hobart Metropolitan Cup and a heat of the Inter Dominion.

A dual Inter Dominion finalist and Miracle Mile placegetter, Robin Hood met and defeated top horses such as Blacks A Fake, Divisive, Smokin Up, Sting Lika Bee, Flashing Red, Gotta Go Cullen, Mister DG and Slipnslide.

Had he remained sound there seemed little doubt that he would have pushed his earnings into the seven figure bracket.

On the score of blood Robin Hood lacks nothing. His sire Fake Left 1:51.4 was a champion with stake earnings in excess of \$3 million and was Australia's premier sire on seven occasions. He figures as the sire of four of Australia's greatest pacers in recent years Blacks A Fake 1:54.7ms, Be Good Johnny 1:54.0ms, Robin Hood 1:55.8ms and Safari 1:55.7ms.



Surfers Paradise, the dam of Robin Hood, was one of the many grand producing daughters of top sire in Vanston Hanover, being out of noted producer in It's Jills Hope, by Keystone Provider (son of Bye Bye Byrd) from Jill's Birthday by Eagle Ambro.

Surfers Paradise was a very smart racemare. She took a record of 2:00.7 and was the winner of \$173,968 and 23 races including the \$250,000 Australian Pacing Gold Final at Harold Park. She was a half sister to Jacks Folly 1:53.8, Izzheamadpunta 1:57.7 and French Hope 2:00 all metropolitan winners.

Another half-sister, Petticoat Tales (by Land Grant) has left four in 2:00 including the Kilmore Cup and Tasmanian Derby winner True Cam 1:58.9 (\$245,212), Ultimate mark 1:57.2 (\$174,546 to date) and The Ultimate One 1:58.2 (\$130,670 to date).

Robin Hood being by Fake Left (out of an Albatross mare) also claims a second strain of Albatross through his damsire Vanston Hanover, by Albatross. His pedigree tree also shows three strong crosses of the blood of Meadow Skipper and a preponderance of Adios and Tar Heel blood.



Robin Hood has everything in his favour – an outstanding race horse, a stout background in blood, great conformation and the fact Yirribee has a history of unearthing exciting young stallions.
